The MS Cap San Diego is the last of six classic cargo ships built for the shipping company Hamburg South, referred to as the "White Swan of the South Atlantic", and is a symbol of the great port city of Hamburg. The "floating witness of maritime history" is nowadays the biggest still mobile civil museum ship worldwide.

Hamburg, the Gateway to the World, the Beauty, and the Highlight of the North: there are good reasons why the green city on the river is said to be one of the most beautiful cities in Germany.

The Free and Hanseatic City of Hamburg, being home to 1.8 million people and hosting more than 7 million tourists every year, looks back to a 1200 years old history mostly affected by the port of Hamburg, which is nowadays the biggest sea port in Germany and a magnet for tourists, and the maritime navigation.

Despite its rich tradition, Hamburg remains a youthful, dynamic and open minded city full of contrasts at the same time. On the one hand, the colorful and simultaneously poorest quarter of the city, the St. Pauli harbor district with its Reeperbahn - the world's reddest of red-light districts. On the other hand the wealthy and noble quarter Blankenese, well-known for its numerous villas and wonderful views from the Elbhang and the lower beaches of the river Elbe. Although each corner of Hamburg looks different, everything joins together harmonically making out the special charm of the second largest city in Germany.
